

# 2012 Florida Network Steps for Hurricane Preparedness

If your agency is in the path of a Tropical Storm/Hurricane, please go online to <a href="www.floridanetwork.org">www.floridanetwork.org</a> and complete the "<a href="Pre-Storm">Pre-Storm</a>" form. Upon completion of the form it will automatically be emailed to Stacy, Karen, and Terry. If you do not have the availability of power please telephone <a href="Karen Miller">Karen Miller</a> at the Florida Network office or see alternate numbers below to give your verbal Pre-Storm information. Karen will be the central point for the collection of all documents and information as well as keeping agencies informed.

# During regular business hours, all staff persons may be reached at 850-922-4324

 Please stay in contact with the Florida Network Office (see above list for contact person), <u>at least</u> every 4 hours <u>if at all possible</u> (as the Network is required to update the DJJ on a regular basis).

If communication method is lost, please call **ASAP** once a communication device is available.

• If your agency WAS in the path of a Tropical Storm/Hurricane, please go online and complete the "Post-Storm" form. Again it will automatically be emailed to Stacy, Karen and Terry. If you do not have the availability of power please telephone Karen Miller at the Florida Network office or see alternate numbers above. You may give a verbal update and the Florida Network staff will take care of the on line completion of the form.
