This project places highly trained professionals in alternative schools to provide a full range of substance abuse prevention and early intervention services. Project SUCCESS counselors use the following intervention strategies: information dissemination, normative and prevention education, problem identification and referral, community-based processes, and environmental approaches. In addition, resistance and social competency skills such as communication, decision making, stress and anger management, problem solving, and resisting peer pressure are taught.
